

"The Girl on the train" to release in India on 14th October 2016

Anil Ambani led Reliance Entertainment and Steven Spielberg's partnership venture, Amblin Partners' film The Girl on the Train, is set to release in India on 14th October 2016.

Based on a psychological thriller novel by British author Paula Hawkins, The Girl on The Train, debuted at No. 1 in the Fiction Best Sellers Category of 2015 list dated February 1, 2015 in the US and remained in the top position for 13 consecutive weeks, until April 2015. In January 2016 it became the No.1 bestseller again for two weeks.

By early August 2015, the book had sold more than 3 million copies in the US alone, and, by August 2016, an incredible 11 million copies worldwide.

The film adaptation stars Emily Blunt, Rebecca Ferguson, Haley Bennett & Justin Theroux amongst others.

The Girl on the Train is a thriller revolving around , Rachel (Emily Blunt), who is devastated by her recent divorce, spends her daily commute fantasizing about the seemingly perfect couple who live in a house that her train passes every day, until one morning she sees something shocking happen there and becomes entangled in the mystery that unfolds.

The film is directed by Tate Taylor who has also helmed the incredibly successful The Help, his previous collaboration with Reliance Entertainment & Steven Spielberg.
